
Haiku Contest

- Takes place in Winter (usually around April for Poetry Month) and is open to students, faculty, and staff.
- Online submission form and paper forms with submission box in the library.
- Only original Haikus are accepted. Haikus are blind-reviewed by a committee of Librarians and English Faculty. Winner announced on social media and placed at top of web page.
- All haikus are published on the library's website.



Buttons

- Started with promotional buttons using the library's name, advertising the Camel Contest.
- Buttons are in plastic bins on the circulation desk.
- Student workers cut images and designs out of withdrawn magazines for buttons.
- Very popular!! Students ask when new buttons will be available.
 - Overheard a student say to a friend as they approached the button bins, "This is where I got my buttons!"

Frequent User Card


- Students get a punch on their card every time they visit the library.
